1. Applications can be submitted via e-mail to tonya.jones@sumteremc.com or by bringing them to one of Sumter EMC's offices in Americus, Cusseta, or Leesburg. Applications must be received or turned in no later than February 15, 2024.
2. The student must be a senior already accepted at an accredited college or technical school, and live in or attend a school in Marion, Schley, Sumter, Webster, Dougherty, Lee, Randolph, Terrell, Chattahoochee, and Stewart counties. ***If the student is not yet accepted at an accredited college or technical college, this information will be required at the time the scholarship is awarded.***
3. Complete the application form with the necessary attachments.
4. **Sumter EMC will award two \$1,000 scholarships.**
5. The Sumter EMC scholarship is not limited to Georgia universities, colleges, or technical schools.
6. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college, junior college, or technical school.
