

- 1. All clearances to be in conformance to the most stringent requirements of either the NESC, NEC or other codes of governmental or regulating authorities as applicable.
- 2. If length of conduit exceeds 10 feet, coupling is permitted an end adjacent to meter.
- Service pole location should always be spotted by Sumter EMC prior to installation.
- This drawing shows Sumter EMC requirements only; check with your local code office for county or city codes, if required, prior to installation.
- Consult with a licensed electrician far conformance to the National Electrical Code (NEC) and local codes, and for proper sizing and installation of conductors and equipment.
- Electrical inspections are required after wiring is completed in Marion, Lee, and Sumter counties before meter is set. Other counties or municipalities may require permits - contact your local government authorities to verify permit requirements.
